

SLATE FLOOR CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDE

***For Slate floor maintenance care: please download the *Marble, Limestone & Travertine floor care guide* and follow the same care instructions

- Slate floors can last for decades
- They are a little bit more porous than marble floors, therefore the impregnator sealers should be applied on a yearly basis after a deep cleaning.
- Slate scratches easily, but you may be able to hide the scratches by applying a bit of mineral oil.
- The Slate floor natural look is dull, impregnator sealers do not change the natural look of the floor, but do their job protecting the stone from spills. You can revive the natural look and enhance the color of your slate floor, by using color enhancers (design for this purpose) prior to the impregnator application.
- Another alternative on sealing floors, is using a topical glossy sealer (sometimes referred to as acrylic or wax). This process of sealing the floor, requires a few applications of the topical sealer, to get the desired glossy finish. Over time the film of the topical glossy finish may wear out and more professional sealing applications may be required to restore the drab/sad worn out areas.

* Caution: Topical sealers are only intended for interior use.
